- keep records of your child's educational progress, provide a full report for the annual review and maintain termly updates of achievement
- invite you to discuss your child's progress with the class teacher and team, at parents' evening, and we will be available to talk to you at additional times as mutually arranged
- keep you informed about your child's experiences at school
- work closely with other professionals to ensure that your child has access to relevant expertise to meet their needs
- work closely with Children with Disabilities/ Children with Complex Needs team/ other social service teams/ Short Breaks teams to safeguard the welfare of your child
- be available to provide advice or signpost you to receive advice
- send home learning tasks home for you to work on with your child
- provide all parents with information about what the children need for school activities. e.g. named clothing; change of clothes, school bag; swimming costume and towel etc

I / We will:-

- support the school and will work with staff to assist my child to achieve
- make sure my child attends school regularly and punctually
- inform the school of the name, address and telephone number of a person who will take responsibility for my child should I be unavailable
- come to my child's Annual Review and parent evenings
- help my child with any home learning she/he may bring home
- contact the school if I have any concerns about my child's education
- send my child to school in a healthy physical state to learn
- inform the school (by 8:30am on day of absence) if my child is sick and when they are expected to return to school
- come to school to collect my child if they are unwell or make alternative arrangements for my child to be collected from school
- if my child is prescribed emergency rescue medication, ensure that the school has an in date supply and inform the school immediately of any changes in this medication
- regularly supply nappies/ pads as needed
- provide suitable clothing necessary for participation in the full curriculum (e.g. swimming costume and towel weekly), as requested by my child's classteacher and ensure items are clearly labeled
- work together to make this partnership agreement a success
